We have an exciting line-up of speakers, including a keynote address by Lady Hale and sessions by Professor Malcolm Shaw and Shaheed Fatima on public international law, Dr Rebecca Williams on Restitution and public law, an update on EU law by Kieron Beal QC and Sarah Lee, Ben Jaffey on hot topics in public law and Martin Westgate QC, Hugh Southey QC and Rosa Curling on judicial review reforms.
